Connecticut Team Championship Invitational

Summary

The Connecticut Team Championship Invitational is an amateur team event, challenging golf clubs throughout Connecticut to compete against each other, making it the ultimate Team Championship event. The Championship is a one-day stroke play team event, consisting of both Gross and Net players from local golf clubs. The event by invitation only for both private and public courses and all team members must represent the same club.

The team with the lowest combined Gross and Net score will be declared Connecticut Team Champion, the best club in the state.

Teams

Invited private and public golf clubs that are members of the Connecticut State Golf Association can field a team to represent their club to compete in the championship. The event is limited to 120 players.

Teams will be comprised of 10 players, with 5 Gross and 5 Net players.

Format

The team with the lowest Team Score will be declared the winner and crowned the Connecticut Team Champion.

Team Score is the combination of the team's overall lowest 4 of 5 Gross and 4 or 5 Net scores.

Individual winners for both Gross and Net will also be determined. In the event of a tie for either individual low gross or low net, there will be a playoff immediately following your round.

Entry Fee

Live Scoring

Scoring will be conducted via the Golf Genius app. Each game will receive a unique GGID before their round. The Golf Genius app will provide a live leaderboard for the Team and Individual contests as well as tracking Gross and Net skins.

Logistics

Bag drop. carts with player and course names, check in table with GGID and scorecards, range balls on range, and tables and chairs set up under the tent for awards. The event will be an 8:30 shotgun start. Food and drinks will be available at each player's expense.
